Randolph Schools E-Learning Days

What are E-Learning Days?

The 2017 MN Legislature amended the length of school year; hours of instruction (Minn. Stat. 120A.41) to include the option of a school utilizing E-Learning days:

- Due to inclement weather
- Up to five days in one school year
- Counted as an instructional day and included as hours of instruction

This day refers to a school day where instead of coming to a school, teachers and students communicate online or set up prior learning expectations, and the students continue their learning from home. On an E-Learning Day, teachers will share assignments and hold office hours in which they are available to provide learning support to students.

What can you expect from Randolph Schools regarding the E-Learning Day process?

- Annual notification E-Learning is a part of the upcoming school calendar.
- Daily notification when E-Learning days occur. This will happen 2 hours prior to the normal school start time via Randolph Schools QuickHits and Text Alert systems.
- Flexibility from teachers regarding when E-Learning assignments are due. This will allow students the support and resource flexibility to complete assignments.
- Communication from your child's teacher(s) regarding the E-Learning plan and assignments.
