#### REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

#### October 19, 2015

- The Randolph School Board met in regular session on Monday, October 19, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. in the Media Center. Gary Moorhouse called the meeting to order. Directors present: Gary Moorhouse, Cory Lorenzen, Jay Otte, Garlan Dubbels and Michael Kelley, Superintendent. Directors absent: Steve Weidner and Sara Taylor. Administrators present: Benjamin Fisher, Matt Rutledge, Aaron Soule and Regina Wernimont. Staff Member Present: Reanna Arnoldi. Guests: Ken Haggerty and Alex Ratzloff.
- 2) A motion to approve the agenda with one addition, to approve the Spanish Class Costa Rica Trip in 2017, was made by Garlan Dubbels, seconded by Jay Otte. All members voting in favor.

- 9) Benjamin Fisher, High School Principal, thanked advisor Kate Esser and reported Dig Pink had an outstanding event this year raising over \$13,000.00, 860 shirts were sold, compliments were received from the officials, over 6 years this event has raised a total of \$40,000.00!
- Aaron Soule, Assistant HS Principal/Activities Director reported on bi-weekly grade checks no student to fail a class, D- or below are called to office, results have gone from 77 to 27 students in 4 weeks; football playoffs are October 20th, waiting for the volleyball seeding from the section; Dennis Murray Region 1A Hall of Fame Recognition, plaque was presented; John Millea from MSHSL will be doing a story on Renville County West at Tuesday nights football playoff game.
- Regina Wernimont, Business Manager, reported the flu shot clinics held at Randolph School serviced 43 staff and 42 community members; True Blue Celebration (formerly known as Project Northland Community Event) was a huge success with over 28 vendors and close to 600 plates of free pizza served; gave the Board a levy update.
- Michael Kelley, Superintendent, reported the long-term facilities maintenance plan approval has been received from MDE; discussed our bus driver shortage (two parents have shown an interest in the training to drive bus); softball scoreboard repainted with new logo; TIES/Synergy student system we are looking at other companies; post crisis meeting with Deputy Gonder.
