SPECIAL SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

November 18, 2016

- 1) The Randolph School Board met in special session on Friday, November 18, 2016, at 7:00 a.m. in the High School Conference Room. Sara Taylor called the meeting to order. Directors present: Garlan Dubbels, Jay Otte, Cory Lorenzen and Sara Taylor. Directors absent: Steve Weidner and Gary Moorhouse. Staff members present: Matt Rutledge, Ben Fisher and Kathy Stauffer.
- 2) A motion to approve the agenda as established was made by Jay Otte, seconded by Garlan Dubbels. All members voting in favor.
- 3) Member Cory Lorenzen moved the adoption of the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS
OF VOTES OF SCHOOL DISTRICT GENERAL ELECTION**

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No. 195, as follows:

1. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the general election of the voters of the district held on November 8, 2016, was in all respects duly and legally called and held.
2. As specified in the attached Abstract and Return of Votes Cast, a total of 2,799 voters of the district voted at said election on the election of three school board members for four year term vacancies on the board caused by expiration of term on the first Monday in January next following the general election as follows:

3. Candidate Sara Taylor, Candidate Jason Quin Podritz, and Candidate Gary Moorhouse, having received the highest number of votes, are elected to four year terms beginning the first Monday in January, 2017.

4. The school district clerk is hereby authorized to certify the results of the election to the county auditor of each county in which the school district is located in whole or in part.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Member Garlan Dubbels and upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor thereof:
