REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

October 16, 2018

- 1) The Randolph School Board met in regular session on Tuesday, October 16, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Media Center. Gary Moorhouse called the meeting to order. Directors present: Gary Moorhouse, Sara Taylor, Cory Lorenzen, Jason Podritz, Jay Otte, Garlan Dubbels and Michael Kelley, Superintendent. Administrators present: Benjamin Fisher, Matt Rutledge, Aaron Soule and Patty Riemenschneider. Staff Members Present: Kathy Stauffer, Jared Rowan and Michael Schmidt.
- 2) A motion to approve the agenda with the addition of one additional winter coach hire, Cameron Quade, was made by Jason Podritz, seconded by Sara Taylor. All members voting in favor.
- 3) A motion was made by Garlan Dubbels, seconded by Cory Lorenzen to approve the following consent agenda items:

- 4) Member, Sara Taylor, introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

- 5) Benjamin Fisher, High School Principal/Special Education Director, reported on the School Law Workshop he attended with Mr. Kelley on September 28; we have 6 students attending DCTC this year.
- 6) Aaron Soule, Assistant HS Principal/Activities Director, reported Homecoming Coronation went well with the program held in the afternoon, Alex Wille and Kenna Foss were crowned king and queen; Dig Pink broke their record again with over \$24,000 raised! Reviewed MN State High School League rules regarding whether an athlete is eligible to play sports when transferring districts.
- 7) Matt Rutledge, Elementary Principal, thanked Lori Underdahl for her work with the Great Lakes Great Apple Crunch! Apples were purchased from the Sogn Valley Orchard for all students to take a “crunch” out of their apples - all at the same time - on October 11. As an added bonus – Lori’s name was drawn out of all the first time registrants and the prize was a surprise lyceum for the students with Crunch from the Timberwolves! Mr. Rutledge also reported on the Title One Open House and Community Education.
- 8) Patty Riemenschneider, Business Manager, reported the flu shot clinics held at Randolph School serviced 41 staff and 37 community members; attended the Tax Levy Workshop with Mr. Kelley; and dental/vision renewals.
- 9) Michael Kelley, Superintendent, congratulated the MN Schools that were randomly awarded the \$25 million in safety grants, unfortunately Randolph School wasn’t one of them; referendum election mailing went out and two community meetings are being held; conducted employee small group meetings with all staff regarding the referendum; need to set date to canvass election results between November 9-16.
