- 5) Sean Kelly, from Wold Architects, updated the School Board on the Randolph School construction project adding on 12 classrooms:
 - July 17 Pre Bid Walk Through, over 12 contractors attended
 - July 30 Bid Opening, 7 bids
 Low bidder was Met-Con out of Faribault, MN for \$4,173,000.00
 (\$3,988,000.00 base bid, plus two alternates \$108,000.00 weight room and \$77,000.00 high school office)
 - August 27 Pre Construction Meeting with Met-Con and primary subs
 - Final permits are ready
- 6) Ben Fisher, High School Principal/Special Education Director, reported we will have doctor coming and talking to the staff during workshop week.
- Aaron Soule, Assistant HS Principal/Activities Director, reported we now have a co-op with Northfield for hockey and swimming; first day of school changes no class meetings it will be a traditional school day with high school bus safety training; Booster Club Open House will be held at the first home volleyball and the first home football games to thank the fans with free popcorn; new softball scoreboard; fall sports picture day is August 28th.
- 8) Elementary Principal, Matt Rutledge, reported team building for elementary staff was held on August 8 which included a cookout and webinars on Reading Without Tears and Renaissance Learning; Community Education including 12U Softball is being recognized for their Sportsmanship Award at the Minnesota Twins game on Saturday, August 24th.
- 9) Michael Kelley, Superintendent, reported the Annual Audit went well the week of July 29th; Teacher's Opening Workshop is August 26, 7:30 a.m.; hosted the Southeast Conference Superintendent Meeting on August 13; looking to purchase a 10 passenger school van; science room has been updated this summer; looking to hire a paraprofessional, door monitor and van route driver; long-term facility maintenance updates; extremely happy with Rose Drinken and Becky Pearson helping us out with painting this summer. Randolph Elementary

School and High School received USDA Healthier US School awards for its leadership role in implementing a healthier school nutrition environment.
