## REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

## July 16, 2019

- The Randolph School Board met in regular session on Tuesday, July 16, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Media Center. Gary Moorhouse called the meeting to order. Directors present: Gary Moorhouse, Jason Podritz, Sara Taylor, Cory Lorenzen, Leah Radman, Regina Wernimont and Michael Kelley, Superintendent. Administrators present: Ben Fisher, Matt Rutledge, Aaron Soule and Patty Riemenschneider. Staff members present: Kathy Stauffer, Rich Qualey, Chris Stanton, and Vanda Pressnall. - 4) Superintendent, Mark Zuzek (along with 917 Board Member, Vanda Pressnall), gave a Power Point presentation on Intermediate School District 917, which was established in 1969. Randolph School is one of the 9 member districts of Intermediate School District 917 which provides services for secondary students in the areas of career and technical education and special education. In 2018-2019 728 students with special needs were serviced, at 25 school sites, with 551 staff members. We also had nine staff members from 917 servicing students in the Randolph School building this past school year. Services provided were: Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Deaf/Hard of Hearing Services, Audiology, and Physical Health Disabilities Teacher consultation. There are four Intermediate School Districts in the State of Minnesota 287, 288, 916 and 917.
- 5) Varsity Baseball Players Andrew Wenstrom, Jackson Buecksler, Joey Erickson, Matt Weber, along with Coaches Chris Stanton and Rich Qualey presented their Section Championship Trophy to the School Board and recapped their season. This was the first time the Randolph School Baseball Team has made it to

- 10) Aaron Soule, Assistant High School Principal/Activities Director, reported sports online registration is now open. Randolph School and Carlton College will be installing new field goal posts purchased from the US Bank Stadium. After the Super Bowl, they no longer fit the US Bank Stadium field specs.
- 11) Patty Riemenschneider, Business Manager, reported the final TIES Building Sale and Maintenance Fee Refund has been received \$3,649.40. Handed out the 2018-2019 Transportation Repair log.
