SPECIAL SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

July 30, 2020

- The Randolph School Board met in special session on Thursday, July 30, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. in the Commons. Gary Moorhouse called the meeting to order. Directors present: Gary Moorhouse, Cory Lorenzen, Leah Radman, Regina Wernimont and Michael Kelley. Directors absent: Jason Podritz and Sara Taylor. Staff members present: Ben Fisher, Aaron Soule, Kathy Stauffer, Jackie Sczepanski, Kate Esser and Susie Lau.
- 2) A motion to approve the agenda as established was made by Leah Radman, seconded by Cory Lorenzen. All members voting in favor.
- The Administration presented the Board with three plans for school start-up this fall due to COVID-19. After a lengthy discussion, a motion was made by Regina Wernimont, seconded by Leah Radman to approve Scenario 2 Hybrid Model. Students in grades PS-6 will attend school in-person, every day. Students in grades 7-9 will alternate every other week with grades 10-12 attending school in-person and distance learning. Mr. Kelley stated this was the best chance at longevity. All students have the option to sign up for a 100% distance learning option. All staff and students will be required to wear a face covering in the school building, at this time, per Governor Walz's Executive Order. However, anyone in Kindergarten or younger OR with a doctor's note will not be required to wear a face covering. All members voting in favor.
